We managed to tape it down with bungee cords. This was the beginning of our troubles. We left Brother Dave's to make it home by June 29. Thank you Pastor Tim and Pastor Dave for a great week of camp and ministering at your churches.

New England Trip July 7 through July 31

I stayed up until three o'clock in the morning getting temporary power and the next morning early we left for Keene, NH. We ministered at another new work that is five years old started by Roger Maxwell, Emanuel Baptist Church. This is once again a great work and they treated us royally. They put us up in a hotel and the service went really great. With all that had happened the night before this was really special. Thank you Pastor Maxwell for the hospitality and your gracious giving. What a blessing. We drove back to Hanscom on Monday. I spent six hours repairing the coach and replacing the transfer switch. I am so thankful that the Lord allowed me to learn electrical work many years ago. I can't imagine what this would have cost. The next Sunday we were with North Baptist Church and this is an older work 150 years old and Pastor Rheed is starting it all over. Please pray for this work. Thank you Pastor for having us. On Monday morning we started back home. We ran into a storm in Carslye, PA where we got hit with seventy mile an hour winds. This was a bad storm which tore our RV awning. What a trip but we are now home safe and sound. Praise the Lord. We can sense the many prayers that are being lifted up for us. Thank You.
