Dear Pastor,

We have now have finished our fourth year of deputation and I am writing this letter to you in our thirty ninth year of the ministry during which I have spent twenty-eight and half years serving as a pastor. I spent five years in evangelism with my wife and four of our five children traveling the United States as the Smeltz Family Evangelistic Team. Today, all of our children are married and we have ten precious grandchildren. Our youngest son is married to a Ukrainian young woman who loves the Lord. For years, I have felt the calling and challenge to work overseas in training national pastors. Now after four years on deputation and visiting over three hundred churches our support level is at 52%. We are members of Bethel Baptist Church in Amherst, Virginia. Our pastor Dave Peters has been my friend for over thirty years. Our church and our pastor are very much a part of our ministry and it is an honor to be missionaries out if this great church. Our goal in going is to train, disciple and assist national pastors in the planting of local churches. We will do this through colleges, seminaries and old and new ministries, which where established in Europe and Asia. We have contacted the leaders of these institutions and ministries and they are willing to work with us. Do to Visa regulations we will embed ourselves with these pastors and nationals on a short-term-basis. Our team will hold evangelistic meetings, discipleship conferences, and soul winning conferences in these countries. We have already made six trips to the Ukraine and one trip to Indonesia, Korea and Russia, Germany and Philippines

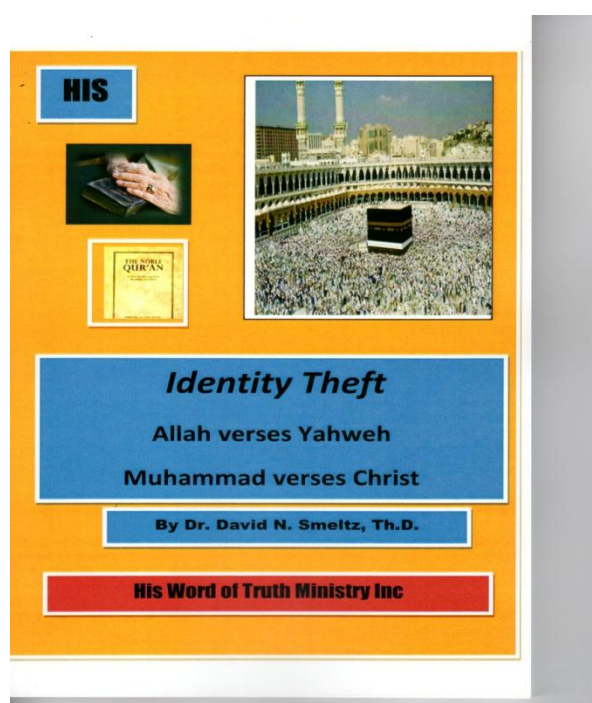
Here is an update for 2010

- Over 400 personal decisions in the Philippines
- 250 national pastors and students attended the Bible Conference
- We had 41 saved in the Philippines
- We had over 85 personal decisions and comments in the Ukraine
- We had 5 people who repented.
- We ministered to around 60 pastors and lay workers teaching in the Bible College.
- I preached in 16 foreign churches in Philippines, Germany and Ukraine
- We ministered to over 5000 people in all in churches and ministries we attended
- We passed out over 2000 tracks.
- We participated in two new church plants in the Ukraine and Philippines
- The total cost of overseas mission trips in the neighborhood of \$10,000.00 given by local churches and private gifts to the ministry.
- We traveled by airlines right at 50,000 miles from July 14 to November 4 2010.
- From January 1, 2010 to November 9, 2010 we have traveled by motor coach and car in the United states over 20,000 miles. We have ministered in 40 churches in the United States.
- Total salvation decisions 133 and over 3000 personal decisions with a total of 2500 tracks passed out January 1, to November 30, 2010. I have preached ten revivals and several Islamic Conferences here in the states in the year 2010. This has been a great year 2010 for His Word of Truth Ministries and we give all the glory to our Lord and Saviour.

In the past thirty-eight years I have assisted in establish twenty- one churches across America and the world. The Lord has also used our family to established five churches from scratch. Within these churches, I have had the privilege of establishing Faith Promise Mission programs

We are doing what we can to support their ministry to Eastern Europe and Asia, As they train and assist National Pastors in Church Planting.

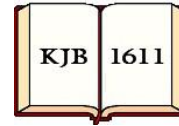

Press Release and Testimony

Biographical Sketch of Dr. David N. Smeltz

Dr. David N. Smeltz received Christ in October of 1969 at Immanuel Baptist Church in Ft. Lauderdale, Florida after returning home from Vietnam. As a decorated veteran and with the war raging and depression setting in from the loss of all his friends, he turned to a drunkenness life style. A young woman suggested Christ and invited him to church. Under the ministry of Ray Sadler, he accepted Christ as his Lord and Saviour. The young woman, Susan Odell of Wayland, Massachusetts became his wife in February 1970 and they began serving at the church where he served as a youth pastor while attending Broward Junior College. In 1973 while ministering as choir director of First Baptist Church, in Margate, Florida, he surrendered to the Gospel Ministry. In January of 1974, he, entered Lynchburg Baptist College in Lynchburg, Virginia and in 1978, he graduated. He started his first church in the fall of 1978 in Halifax, Va. and within the first year, the church grew from zero to over 125 people baptizing 68 individuals. Within two years, the church purchased ten acres of land, built a new sanctuary, and started a Christian School and day care.

In 1981, he assumed the pastorate at Fellowship Baptist Church in South Bend Indiana. Within four years, the church grew to a high attendance of over 700 on a special day. A Christian Day Care, a Christian School and Bible Institute were started. Pastor Smeltz applied with Anchor Theological Seminary in Texarkana, Arkansas and completed A Master degree in Theology in 1982. In October of 1985, he received his Doctorate of Divinity from Anchor Theological Seminary. He also attended Jay Adam's school of Counseling and graduated in 1983. He has pastored in Sumner, Washington, New York City and Virginia. While earning these degrees he also earned his Master's in mechanical, plumbing, and electrical contracting.

In the past thirty-eight nine, he has assisted in planting over twenty-one churches in America and foreign countries. Under his leadership, he has also re-established five churches. In 2001, he assumed the pastorate of Faith Baptist Church of Rustburg, Virginia and led the church until December of 2006 when he and his wife surrendered to a fourth quarter ministry of training national pastors. In 2004 he was appointed Chaplain of the Vietnam Veterans of America, State of Virginia. His ministry reaches the Veterans, men, and women who have been and are incarcerated in State and Federal prisons. He has had the privilege of speaking at national cemetery function, national meetings, and many conferences associated with veterans and veteran's organizations. He is powerful speaker who reaches and touches the hearts of the veterans. His Military decorations include: Commendation Medal with V device for valor, Vietnamese- Cross of Gallantry Medal, Presidential Citation Medal and other medals associated with the Vietnam era. In 1965, he received a Congressional approval from State of Florida Congressmen Claude Pepper to attend West Point, but due to the war, he did not have the opportunity to attend.

Over the last thirty-nine years, he has ministered in over 1000 churches including ministries in Brazil, Indonesia, Philippines and Europe. His Word of Truth Ministries began in 1973 as an evangelist. In 1997, he began "Just a Daily Thought," an internet devotional ministry that now reaches thousands. Dr. Smeltz has served as an active Chaplain for the Vietnam Veterans of America since 1999 and many other organizations. Under his leadership and guidance of the Holy Spirit, thousands have come to know Christ. He has published several books and pamphlets. The teaching book "The Five Fundamentals of the faith of Islam" has become a ministry of teaching around the world. Brother Smeltz began in 2008 teaching conferences on Islam in many churches here in the states and abroad. In January of 2011 he published a book called "Identity Theft" This book compares Allah with Yahweh and Christ with Muhammad and answers the question is Allah the Islamic god the same God as Yahweh?

He and his wife Susan serve in the Ukraine, Philippines, Indonesia, and Russia as missionaries training national pastors. He can be reached through the web site www.drdauidsmeltz.org

What We Believe

Of The Scriptures

We believe that the Holy Bible was written by men supernaturally inspired; that it has truth without any admixture of error for its matter; and therefore is, and shall remain to the end of the age, the only complete and final revelation of the will of God to man; the true center of Christian union and the supreme standard by which all human conduct, creeds, and opinions should be tried.

1. By "The Holy Bible" we mean that collection of sixty-six books, from Genesis to Revelation, which, as originally written does not only contain and convey the Word of God, but IS the very Word of God.

2. By "inspiration" we mean that the books of the Bible were written by holy men of old, as they were moved by the Holy Spirit, in such a definite way that their writings were supernaturally and verbally inspired and free from error, as no other writings have ever been or ever will be inspired.

Of The True God

We believe that there is one, and only one, living and true God, an infinite, intelligent Spirit, the maker and supreme ruler of heaven and earth; inexpressibly glorious in holiness and worthy of all possible honor, confidence and love; that in the unity of the Godhead there are three persons, the Father, the Son and the Holy Ghost, equal in every divine perfection, and executing distinct but harmonious offices in the great work of redemption.

Of The Holy Spirit

We believe that the Holy Spirit is a divine person; equal with God the Father and God the Son and of the same nature; that He was active in the creation; that in His relation to the unbelieving world He restrains the evil one until God's purpose is fulfilled; that He convicts of sin, of judgment and of righteousness; that He bears witness to the Truth of the Gospel in preaching and testimony; that He is the agent in the New Birth; that He seals, endues, guides, teaches, witnesses, sanctifies and helps the believer.

Of The Devil, Or Satan

We believe that Satan was once holy, and enjoyed heavenly honors; but through pride and ambition to be as the Almighty, fell and drew after him a host of angels; that he is now the malignant prince of the power of the air, and the unholy god of this world. We hold him to be man's great tempter, the enemy of God and His Christ, the accuser of the saints, the author of all false religions, the chief power back of the present apostasy; the lord of the antichrist, and the author of all the powers of darkness - destined however to final defeat at the hands of God's own Son, and to the judgment of an eternal justice in hell, a place prepared for him and his angels.

Of The Creation

We believe in the Genesis account of creation and that it is to be accepted literally, and not allegorically or figuratively; that man was created directly in God's own image and after His own likeness; that man's creation was not a matter of evolution or evolutionary change of species, or development through interminable periods of time from lower to higher forms; that all animal and vegetable life was made directly and God's established law was that they should bring forth only "after their kind." Since God created mankind into genders distinctly male and female, we believe that the only legitimate marriage is that between a man and a woman. He has commanded that no intimate sexual activity be engaged in outside of marriage. We believe that any form of homosexuality, lesbianism, bisexuality, bestiality, incest, fornication, adultery and pornography are sinful perversions of God's gift of sex. We believe that God rejects any attempt to alter one's gender by surgery or appearance.

Of The Fall of Man

We believe that man was created in innocence under the law of his Maker, but by voluntary transgression fell from his sinless and happy state, in consequence of which all mankind are now sinners, not by constraint, but of choice; and therefore under just condemnation without defense or excuse.

Of The Virgin Birth

We believe that Jesus Christ was begotten of the Holy Ghost in a miraculous manner; born of Mary, a virgin, as no other man was ever born or can ever be born of a woman, and that He is both the Son of God, and God, the Son.

Of The Atonement for Sin

We believe that the salvation of sinners is wholly of grace; through the mediatorial offices of the Son of God, Who by appointment of the Father, freely took upon Him our nature, yet without sin, honored the divine law by His personal obedience, and by His death made a full and vicarious atonement for our sins; that His atonement consisted not in setting us an example by His death as a martyr, but was the voluntary substitution of Himself in the sinner's place, the Just dying for the unjust, Christ, the Lord, bearing our sins in His own body on the tree; that, having risen from the dead, He is now enthroned in heaven and uniting in His wonderful person the tenderest sympathies with divine perfection, He is in every way qualified to be a suitable, a compassionate and an all sufficient Savior.

Of Grace in the New Creation

We believe that in order to be saved, sinners must be born again; that the new birth is a new creation in Christ Jesus; that it is instantaneous and not a process; that in the new birth the one dead in trespasses and in sins is made a partaker of the divine nature and receives eternal life, the free gift of God; that the new creation is brought about in a manner above our comprehension, not by culture, not by character, nor by the will of man, but wholly and solely by the power of the Holy Spirit in connection with divine truth, so as to secure our voluntary obedience to the gospel; that its proper evidence appears in the holy fruits of repentance and faith and newness of life.

Of The Freeness of Salvation

We believe in God's electing grace; that the blessings of salvation are made free to all by the gospel; that it is the immediate duty of all to accept them by a cordial, penitent and obedient faith; and nothing prevents the salvation of the greatest sinner on earth but his own inherent depravity and voluntary rejection of the gospel; which rejection involves him in an aggravated condemnation.

Of Justification

We believe that the great gospel blessing which Christ secures to such as believe in Him is Justification; that Justification includes the pardon of sin, and the gift of eternal life on principles of righteousness; that it is bestowed not in consideration of any works of righteousness which we have done; but solely through faith in the Redeemer's blood, His righteousness is imputed unto us.

Of Repentance and Faith

We believe that Repentance and Faith are solemn obligations, and also inseparable graces, wrought in our souls by the quickening Spirit of God; thereby, being deeply convicted of our guilt, danger and helplessness, and of the way of salvation by Christ, we turn to God with unfeigned contrition, confession and supplication for mercy; at the same time heartily receiving the Lord Jesus Christ and openly confessing Him as our only and all-sufficient Savior.

Of The Church

We believe that a Baptist church is a congregation of baptized believers associated by a covenant of faith and fellowship of the Gospel, said church being understood to be the citadel and propagator of the divine and eternal grace; observing the ordinances of Christ; governed by His laws; exercising the gifts, rights, and privileges invested in them by His Word; that its officers of ordination are pastors or elders whose qualifications, claims, and duties are clearly defined in the scriptures.

We believe that men and women are spiritually equal in position before God but that God has ordained distinct and separate spiritual functions of men and women in the home and in the church. The husband is to be the leader of the home and men are to hold the leadership positions (pastors and deacons) in the church. Accordingly, only men are eligible of licensure and ordination for pastor by the church.

We believe the true mission of the church is found in the Great Commission: first, to make individual disciples; second, to build up the church; third, to teach and instruct as He has commanded. We do not believe in the reversal of this order; we hold that the local church has the absolute right of self government, free from the interference of any hierarchy of individuals or organizations; and that the one and only superintendent is Christ through the Holy Spirit; that it is scriptural for true churches to cooperate with each other in contending for the faith and for the furtherance of the Gospel; that every church is the sole and only judge of the measure and method of its cooperation; on all matters of membership, of policy, of government, of discipline, of benevolence, the will of the local church is final.

Of Baptism and the Lord's Supper

We believe that Christian baptism is the immersion in water of a believer, in the name of the Father, of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost, with the authority of the local church, to show forth in a solemn and beautiful emblem our faith in the crucified, buried and risen Savior, with its effect in our death to sin and resurrection to a new life; that it is prerequisite to the privileges of a church relation and to the Lord's supper, in which the members of the church, by the sacred use of bread and the fruit of the vine are to commemorate together the dying love of Christ; preceded always by solemn self-examination. *Matthew 3:6; 3:16; 28:19-20; John 3:23; Acts 2:41-42; 8:36-39; Romans 6:3-5; 1Corinthians 11:23-28; Colossians 2:12*

Of The Perseverance of the Saints

We believe that such only are real believers as endure unto the end; that their persevering attachment to Christ is the grand mark which distinguishes them from superficial professors; that a special Providence watches over their welfare; and that they are kept by the power of God through faith unto eternal salvation.

We believe that there is a radical and essential difference between the righteous and the wicked; that such only as through faith are justified in the name of the Lord Jesus, and sanctified by the Spirit of our God, are truly righteous in His esteem; while all such as continue in impenitence and unbelief are in His sight wicked, and under the curse, and this distinction holds among men both in and after death, in the everlasting felicity of the saved and the everlasting conscious suffering of the lost.

Under Grace we give, and do not pay, the tithe - "Abraham GAVE the tenth of the spoils," - Hebrews 7:2,4 - and this was four hundred years before the law, and is confirmed in the new Testament; Jesus said concerning the tithe, "these ought ye to have done", Matthew 23:23.

We are commanded to bring the tithe into the common treasury of the church.

Leviticus 27:30, "The tithe ... is the Lord's."

Malachi 3:10, "Bring ye all the tithes into the storehouse, that there may be meat in mine house, and prove me now herewith, saith the Lord of hosts, if I will not open you the windows of heaven, and pour you out a blessing, that there shall not be room enough to receive it."

In the New Testament it was the common treasury of the church.

Acts 4:34,35,37, "And brought the prices of the things that were sold and laid them down at the apostles' feet ... Having land, sold it, and brought the money, and laid it AT THE APOSTLES' FEET."

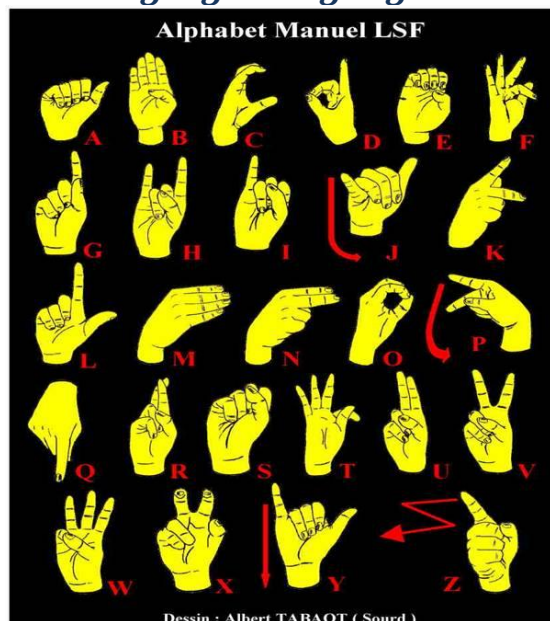
